Target Audience

Appropriate for all members of the ECO, including Chief and Deputy Chief Wardens, Floor Wardens and Wardens, First Aid Officers and Communication Officers. The Warden's role in an emergency is to safely evacuate occupants and visitors in an orderly manner

Course Overview

- Meets the requirements of the Australian Standards A3745-2010 and/or legislation and Building Fire Safety Regulation 2008 for evacuation coordination instruction.
- How to operate as part of an emergency control organisation. To enable Wardens to carry out their duties in an emergency.

- To understand how to best operate as part of the ECO and carry out their duties in the event of an emergency, while meeting Australian standards for emergency control.
- Emergency response processes based on different types of emergencies that could be encountered in your workplace.
- How to implement and coordinate the established Emergency Response Procedures, including:
 - Alerting and communicating potential workplace emergencies.
 - Evaluating the need to evacuate a workplace in an emergency situation.
 - Preparing and arranging the evacuation.
 - Assisting people in accordance with the Personal Emergency Evacuation Plan (PEEP).

Pre-requisite

General Evacuation /First Response Instruction training.

Training must be completed:

- Within **1 month** before the person becomes responsible for carrying out the evacuation coordination procedure as part of a member of the ECO and
- **Every 12 months** to each person working in the building.
