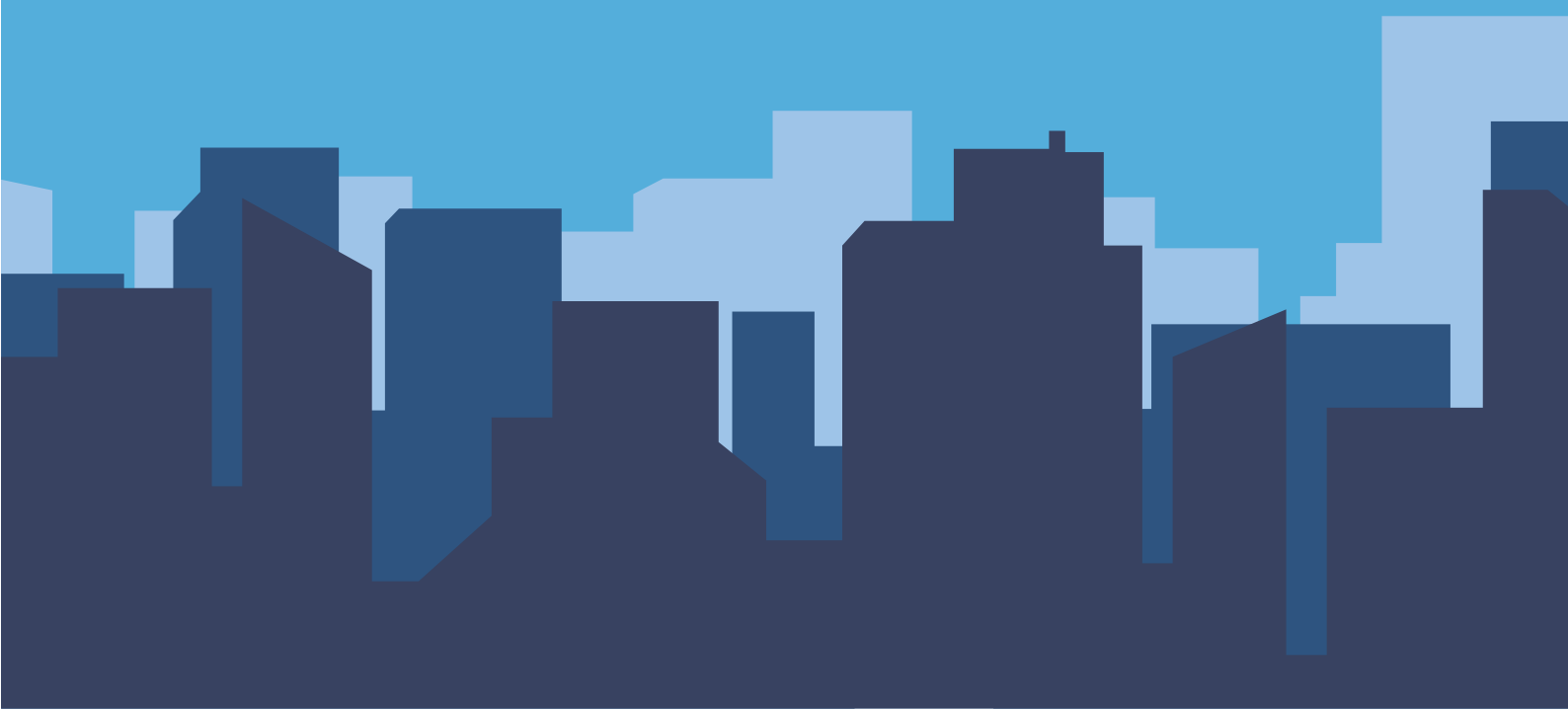

Target Audience

- Meets the requirements of the Australian Standards A3745-2010 and/or legislation and Building Fire Safety Regulation 2008 for general evacuation and first response evacuation instruction.

- Introduction to fire extinguishers and appropriate equipment to use in the event of an emergency.

- To identify and explain fire safety equipment and learn the procedure for evacuating the building safely according to the fire and evacuation program.
- Emergency response processes based on different types of emergencies that could be encountered in your workplace.
- To locate fire-fighting equipment and site safety installations at your workplace in the interactive floor plan.
